

Gospel Masculinity - Father's Day Sermon

June 21, 2020: Sermon Notes

I. Gospel Masculinity: The Definition

"Be watchful, stand firm in the faith, act like men, be strong. Let all that you do be done in love." (I Corinthians 16:13-14)

"For the husband is the head of the wife as Christ is the head of the church, his body, of which he is the Savior." (Ephesians 5:23a)

A. Initiate. *"We love because he first loved us." I John 4:19; "My son, do not despise the Lord's discipline, and do not resent his rebuke, because the Lord disciplines those he loves, as a father the son he delights in." (Proverbs 3:11,12)*

B. Service. *"Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves." (Philippians 2:3)*

C. Staying. *"For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and the two will become one flesh.' So they are no longer two, but one flesh. Therefore what God has joined together, let no one separate." (Matthew 19:5-6)*

II. Gospel Masculinity: The Source

"Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her." (Ephesians 5:25a)

"And a voice from heaven said, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased." (Matthew 3:17)
